## Job Title: Handyperson / Facilities Support – Community Hub

### **Reports To: Community Hub Manager**

#### Job Purpose:

To support the smooth running of our community hub by carrying out day-to-day maintenance, repairs, and setup duties. The handyperson will help create a safe, welcoming, and well-functioning environment for all users, including staff, volunteers, and members of the local community.

#### **Key Responsibilities:**

- General Maintenance: Carry out basic repairs (e.g., plumbing, minor electrical, carpentry, decorating) and report major issues to the Manager.
- **Building Checks:** Perform regular inspections of the premises, ensuring fire exits are clear, lighting and heating are operational, and the space is safe and tidy.
- Health & Safety: Monitor safety hazards, report concerns, and carry out minor remedial work in line with health and safety policies.
- **Supplies and Inventory:** Keep basic tools, lightbulbs, cleaning products, and repair materials stocked and organised.
- **Community Engagement:** Interact courteously with hub users, sometimes responding to minor queries if required.
- Flexibility: Be available for work outside of operating hours if maintenance work disrupts service provision.

#### **Skills and Qualifications:**

- Broad practical experience in general maintenance and repair work.
- Ability to carry out manual tasks, lift equipment, and operate hand tools safely.
- Basic knowledge of plumbing, electrics, and building maintenance.
- Good communication and people skills, especially with diverse community members.
- Ability to work both independently and as part of a small, friendly team.
- Understanding of safeguarding and confidentiality (training will be provided).

- Previous experience in a community, school, or charity environment.
- Familiarity with community-centred values and inclusive spaces.
- Trade qualifications or health & safety training (e.g., COSHH, PAT testing, Manual Handling).
